## Membership Eligibility Criteria

In order to qualify for Membership of either the Business User Scheme or Personal User Scheme, you must:

- be employed either full-time or part-time by a Company that has subscribed to CCC's Business User Scheme and have been approved by both the Company and CCC for Membership
- be at least 22 years of age and no more than 75 years of age
- must hold a full UK Driving Licence issued by the DVLA and have held it for a minimum of 12 months,
- not have any of the following convictions on your driving licence (or within the period of 5 years prior to the date of application for membership):-  
UT10, UT20, UT30, UT40, UT50  
CD40, CD50, CD60, CD70  
DD30, DD40, DD60, DD70, DD80, DR10, DR20, DR30, DR40, DR50, DR60, DR70, DR80, DR90

- not be employed either part-time or full-time in any of the following professions, namely amusement caterers, directors or producers involved in film, stage, radio or television, fairground showmen or other circus employees, itinerant traders or workers, models, pop musicians, members of the entertainment industry, professional sports persons and / or sports personalities
- have no more than 6 penalty points on your driving licence
- not have been involved in more than 1 accident in the previous 3 years prior to the date of application for Membership
- not have made more than 1 claim in the last 3 years for fire, theft / attempted theft of a motor vehicle
- not have been disqualified from driving for a period exceeding 6 months in the 3 years prior to the date of application for membership or have been disqualified for a period exceeding 3 months during the previous year prior to the date of application for membership.

If you do not fulfil the eligibility requirements above, your employer may request an individual insurance quotation for you. Eligibility in such circumstances may be subject to the Company paying an additional insurance premium.
